Paper Submission

Submissions will be handled through *Easy Chair*. Contributions should be submitted in the form of extended abstracts (max 2 pages) as PDF files to *Easy Chair* (for which an *Easy Chair* account is needed). The first page of the submitted material must contain authors' affiliations and, at least, three keywords. In case of co-authored research, the submitter will be assumed to be the presenter, unless differently specified. Only one paper per presenter is allowed. The submission system opens on **January 15, 2024**. Further details will be posted on the conference website.

- Deadline for submissions: **February 29, 2024**
- Notification of acceptance: **March 31, 2024**

Registration and Fees

Participants who wish to present a paper must register and pay the submission fee by **May 15, 2024**. Details will be posted on the conference website.

- Fee for regular participants: 450 EUR
- Fee for currently enrolled (PhD) students: 375 EUR
